
# FW434 & FW435 Module Box



# DESCRIPTION

The FW434 and FW435 are module boxes allowing the installation of multiple Maple Armor modules into one cabinet. FW434 can fit up to 16 modules and FW435 can fit up to 8 modules. They integrate an external door, two mounting plates, and a backbox. They meet the UL864 10th Edition Listed standard and the ULC-S527 4th Edition Listed standard.



# INSTALLATION

The cabinet must be fastened securely to a clean, dry, shock-free, and vibration-free surface in a protected environment. When mounting the cabinet, position the cabinet clear of obstructions so that the door can open freely.

 Mount the standard modules and mini-input modules onto each slot on the backbox using four #6-32 screws provided. See Figure 1.






Figure 2 Installation of modules

- 2. Connect the wire for each module. Refer to respective manuals for more details.
- 3. Mount the cover onto the backbox using the screws provided.




Figure 3 Cover Mounting

- 4. Mark the locations of the two upper mounting bolts of the cabinet on the wall. Drill the two holes marked into the wall and screw in the top bolts, leaving a small gap between the wall and each top bolt.
- 5. Place the cabinet over the two top bolts and allow it to slide down over the bolts.
- 6. Mark the locations of the two bottom mounting bolts of the cabinet on the wall. drill the two holes marked into the wall and screw in the bottom bolts, leaving a small gap between the wall and each bottom bolt.
- 7. Tighten all four bolts securely against the back wall of the cabinet.
