Our partners at Phoenix Fire were tasked with installing the fire alarm system for Popeyes' new location at 46325 Yale Road in Chilliwack, BC. Looking to gain experience with a new player on the market, the electrical contractor was excited with Maple Armor's product offering for this new construction.

The new system includes Maple Armor's FW106S single-loop panel and FW122 compact annunciator. It also includes the FW511 smoke detector, the FW721 manual stations, and the FW962 Horn/Strobes. Furthermore, the system required the FW811 Input Module, the FW831 Relay Module, and the FW851 Isolator Module.

Given the small nature of the project, the installation was completed in only one day by two technicians.
